

## *Scottie Aschermann Memorial Seasonal Club Championship Meet*

- DATE:** July 31, August 1, & 2, 2009
- SANCTION:** Held under sanction of Colorado Swimming, Inc. of USA Swimming # 2009-083
- LOCATION:** Riverside Park on North Main (Hwy 52) Ft Morgan
- DIRECTIONS:** 1-76 east to exit 80, north ¼ mile on Hwy 52 to park on east side of road.
- THEME:** **Pirates on the Plains**
- FACILITIES:** 6 lanes, 25-yard outdoor pool, non-turbulent land ropes. Seating available for spectator and a full concession stand will be available.
- TIMING:** Electronic Semi-Automatic two timers per lane. Hy-tek Meet Manager Software will be used for record management.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All athletes *must* hold a 2009 *Seasonal* USA Swimming membership card issued by Colorado Swimming, Inc. Swimmers who are within the 120-day transfer rule must swim UNATTACHED. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI exception report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their current card. No deck registration will be taken. Exception report will be posted on the CSI web page after the entry deadline, at [csi.org](http://csi.org).

No athlete shall be eligible to compete in the CSI State Seasonal Club Championship Meet who is registered as a year round swimmer.

**SCORING:** Individual Events: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1  
Relays Events: 32-26-24-22-20-18-14-10-8-6-4-2

**AWARDS:** Teams: Large Team 1-3 Small Team 1-3

Individual: High point awards for top male and female in each age group.  
Individual: Medals 1-6 Ribbons 7-12  
Relays: Medals 1-3 Ribbons 4-6  
19&O Events will not score points but awards will be given.

**SEEDING PROCEDURE & SCRATCH RULES:**

The meet shall be pre-seeded. Swimmers must report to the assigned heat and lane if they intend to swim the event. Relay events shall be seeded according to the times reflected on the entry submission. All swimmers must be listed on the entry submission to be eligible to compete on a relay team. Declarations of the relay must include: (1) First and last names, (2) Ages, (3) Order of swimming and (4) Alternate swimmers. This information is to be filled out completely for each relay team entered and given to the clerk of course at

least 45minutes prior to the beginning of the first relay event to be swum that session. All relays must be declared at that time to be eligible to compete in relay events. The order of swimmers declared on the cards may be changed at any time prior to the start of the heat.

**RULES:**

1. Current 2009 USA Rules will govern the meet.
2. Swimmers may use the May 15th date to determine the swimmer's age group for competition; however, each swimmer must compete in only one age group.
3. ***Submit entry times according to the time swam – DO NOT SUBMIT CONVERTED TIMES, i.e. if the Q time was done in long course meters submit the long course time.*** After the nonconforming qual times have been verified, all nonconforming times will be converted to the appropriate course and the meet will be seeded accordingly.
4. No exhibition swimming will be permitted.
5. All events are timed finals. Swimmers shall report promptly to the blocks prior to the start of each race in which they are entered. Swimmers not reporting for or competing in an individual event will not be penalized.
6. The meet is pre-seeded with the exception of the 400 IM, 500 Free & 1650 Free, positive check required. Notify the clerk of scratches only.
7. A maximum of two (2) relay teams per club per event will be permitted. No unattached swimmers on any relay or unattached relays. Teams entered with no entry time or “NT” will be seeded last.
8. This is a qualifying meet. All entry times will be verified with the CSI time’s database before the swimmer will be allowed to swim that event. A no proof of times report will be posted on the CSI web page after the entry deadline at [csi.org](http://csi.org). Team Entry Chair or coaches will then have 48 hours to correct or provide proof of time. (Exception for disabled swimmers. See rule #16.)
9. Official meet results from USA sanctioned meets and approved Colorado High School Meets swum between April 1, 2009 and the registration deadline for this meet, for which CSI has received official results, will be accepted as proof of time. Other items such as non-sanctioned USA/HS dual meet results, newspapers, magazines, ribbons, etc. will not be accepted.
10. The MEET REFEREE will have the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet.
11. Colorado Swimming, Inc. procedures for warm-up will be followed.
12. At the Meet Referee's discretion, individual and/or relay events may be combined by age, sex and/or distance.
13. The 400 IM, the 500 freestyle and the 1650 freestyle will be deck seeded by the clerk based on positive check-in. Distance swimmers must provide at least one backup timer. If lap counters are used, the swimmer or the swimmer’s team must provide them.
14. At the referee’s discretion, the 1650 may be swum fast to slow, alternating heats between girls and boys, and 2 swimmers per lane.
15. The 1650 will be swum as a combined 13& O event but will be scored separately.
16. Seasonal Swimmers who are recognized by CSI as having disabilities may enter the State meet without making the q-time. These swimmers may also swim in an age group,

which would be more appropriate. All disabled athlete entries will be done under the coach's guidance. The entry chair may assist the coach in determining an appropriate age group/event/heat. Any special awards (participation) given to the disabled athlete will be the responsibility of the athlete's team. The entry chair may refuse an entry if it is inappropriate.

**COACHES/OFFICIALS:**

All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches that are in non-compliance and spectators will not be allowed on deck. A coaches' meeting will be held approximately 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the morning warm-up both Friday and Saturday.

**ENTRIES:**

Age 8 and under swimmers will be permitted to enter and swim no more than five individual events and two relays per day. All other swimmer will be permitted to enter no more than four individual events and one relay event per day.

**ENTRY FEES:**

\$10.00 for each relay event.  
\$ 5.00 for each individual event. (.60 cents of each individual event will go to the CSI Support Fund)  
\$ 5.00 Pool Surcharge

**ENTRY PROCEDURES:**

Entries may be sent using HY-TEK Entry format either on a 3.5-inch disk or email, complete with all required information (name, team, USA number, time, age, and event number, Team and Coach information including phone numbers). Relay only swimmers must also be listed on the master sheets. Also be sure to include a hard copy printout of the team entry report and team roster report in duplicate. CLUBS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INTEGRITY OF THEIR ELECTRONIC INFORMATION!

IF YOU DO **NOT** USE THE HY-TEK ENTRY FORMAT All entries must be on CSI master entry sheets (available from the CSI Office). These sheets must include the swimmer's name, age, correct USA#, approved team code, event #, and entry time. Relay only swimmers must also be listed on the master sheets. "N.T." and incorrect entries will be rejected! A separate master sheet for EACH age group and sex is required with swimmers listed alphabetically. These sheets are to be sent in duplicate to the Entry Chairman, as listed below. All entries must include preparer's name and phone number. Coach's name and phone number and address for results. All entries must be sent to entry chairman, do not send to the pool.

Entry Corrections to the posted psych sheets will be allowed for 48 hours after they are posted.

**ALL ENTRY TIMES ARE TO BE EXPRESSED IN TIME SWUM NO CONVERSION**

**A CSI Meet Verification form and check list must accompany all entries.**

**ENTRY DEADLINE:**

The entry chairman must receive entries no later than 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, **July 21, 2009.** All entries must be in the entry chairman's possession by the deadline. Any means of delivery is acceptable.

**ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER DEADLINE!**

**EXCEPTION: Only** those swimmers archiving a qualifying time at the League meets the weekend after the deadline. This is only for those swimmers that had not previously qualified in that event. No previous times will be adjusted. Entries will be collected by the host team and forwarded to the entry chairman.

**PROGRAMS AND RESULTS:**

Programs will be available for \$ 5.00. Meet program/heat sheet and final results will be provided to teams entered in the meet. Teams wanting meet results in soft-copy at the conclusion of the meet must notify the meet director prior to the beginning of the final session and provide a clean floppy disk (no other files and on viruses on the disk).

**OFFICIALS:**

Each team is asked to provide officials for the meet. Please include names and certification levels of your officials with your team entries. A mandatory officials' meeting will be held at the start of warm-up for each session, each day of the meet. Officials attire will be white on top & navy bottoms; shorts, skirts, or long pants. No trainee officials will be allowed on deck.

Requirements for back-up timers and place-pickers will be determined by the numbers of entries each team has in that session. Teams will be responsible for ensuring that timers and place-pickers are at session briefings (approximately 30 minutes prior to the beginning of each session) and are in position at the beginning and throughout each session.

**SAFETY ISSUES:**

With the exception of those lanes specifically identified as dive lanes, **all swimmers must enter warm-up lanes using a 3-point feet-first entry where both feet and one hand must be in contact with the deck or end wall immediately prior to entering the water.** Marshals/Officials/Meet Personnel/Staff who observe swimmers to be in non-compliance will make every effort to contact/warn said swimmer and/or their coach of the improper action. Consequences for non-compliance, if deemed to be repetitive, willful, or deliberately defiant by the observer, **MAY** include removal of the swimmer for the remainder of the session/competition **and/or** a \$500 fine to be paid by the athlete/coach/team/parent prior to said swimmer being allowed to compete in any future Colorado Swimming, Inc. sanctioned competition.

- All coaches, officials, parents and swimmers should act in a manner to reduce the risk of any accidents.
- Swimmers are **required** to enter the water *feet first* and it is preferred that they **slip-&-slide into the water during warm-ups!** That is, sit down on the side of the pool and slip/slide into the water.
- Coaches are to monitor their swimmers during warm-up/meet and are responsible for their safety.
- No forward dives or backstroke starts into the water during warm-up unless there is one-way swimming & starts with coach supervision.
- All athletes, visiting coaches and officials are reminded that the swimming venue may have areas where additional care needs to be observed. This includes and is not limited to slippery deck, bleachers and hallways. Proper footwear and caution "may" help reduce these risks.
- No running or horseplay is allowed and it is the responsibility of the swimmer, coach, officials and parents to monitor these activities.
- Care should be given not to park in either handicapped or fire lanes as vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense.

**TEAM MEETING:**

The annual Seasonal Club Team Representative's meeting will be held on Saturday, August 1<sup>st</sup> following conclusion of the second session. The meeting will convene shortly after the conclusion of the afternoon session. Listen for public address system announcements concerning the location of the meeting. Everyone interested the business of the meeting is invited to attend, but note that each team has only one vote. **SEASONAL CLUB COACH AND SWIMMER OF THE YEAR AWARD:**

Nomination information and criteria:

- Must be a registered coach with CSI for at least 120 days.
- Must represent a USA/CSI registered seasonal club.
- Must be a USA member in good standing.
- Must be recognized as an individual with a positive professional attitude towards seasonal swimming.
- Must demonstrate behavior synonymous with that of a positive adult role model.
- Must be of strong moral fiber and exemplify standards of character, which bring credit to the sport of competitive swimming.
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Anyone may nominate a swimmer or coach for the award. The nomination is taken in the form of a written paragraph that states how/why the nominee is a positive role model, who promotes sportsmanship and competition through the sport of swimming.

Nominations are closed at some point during our annual seasonal team meeting which follows the last session on Saturday of the meet. The written paragraphs are the posted for swimmers, parents and officials to read. Ballots are produced. Each team will have three votes for each position; for coach of the year each team has two coach votes & one athlete vote, for swimmer of the year each team has one coach vote and two athlete votes. The winners will be announced during the team and individual trophy presentations.

**SPIRIT AWARD:**

The Spirit Award will be chosen by the Meet Referee, Seasonal Rep/Meet Director, a coach, official & Seasonal Athlete Rep. The award is based on the team that best exemplifies the characteristics of sportsmanship and team commradery, a willingness to help other teams or swimmers, and support fair swimming competition. Teams must be a registered participant in this seasonal meet to be nominated.
